Beliefs of Rapha Foundation

Rapha Foundation believes that, through combined
resources from various disciplines, integrated healing can be
brought to individuals suffering from emotional distress.
More importantly, we believe that God's healing stems from
the church communities, through which plays an important
role in the healing process. In addition, professional
analysis, and guidance of counselors/ therapists, as well as
the practice of spiritual discipline and support from cell
groups are important factors to facilitate the healing process
as well as providing crucial support and encouragement to
the individuals. Rapha Foundation aims to explore the

integration of Christianity with psychological healing through
the actual practice.

Financial support to individuals requiring professional counseling/ psychotherapy

The Foundation aims at helping individuals who suffer from
emotional distress, and requiring professional
counseling/psychotherapy, but is unable to do so due to
financial difficulties; the church and other
psychological/counseling organizations alone may not have
sufficient resources to support this group of individuals.
Thus in this program, counseling/therapy costs will be
shared between the Foundation, the church, the client and
the therapist. As such the church plays an important role
in the holistic healing process in providing spiritual, financial
and psychological support to the emotionally distressed, as
it is vital to experience the healing power of God through
the body of Christ. Therefore the Foundation is
collaborating with various churches on providing for these
needs.

Supplementary Courses

The Wholeness in Healing series is developed based on the
theories of psychology, the way how God' s healing and
spiritual renewal through the ages are experienced, as well
as Biblical teachings. Its aim is to help people understand
themselves, people, and God better, and to be able to live
out the richness of life in Christ. This series of course
consists of three books including: (Emotion Quartet -
Walking Through the Four Basic Emotion in Life) • (Journey
in the Wilderness - Transformation of Emotion in Life) •
(Life-transformed Healing - Walking Through Emotional
Moments with Jesus) . Rapha Foundation has jointly

Rapha Foundation believes that worship and praise is a good
remedy to psychological healing and a source of strength.
We hope to produce suitable worship songs for emotionally
troubled brothers and sisters; to help them express their
inner struggles through the lyrics and leading them into
prayers, as well as letting the Biblical truth enters their
hearts to strengthen their faith in God.

A platform for dialogue and integration

The Holistic Healing Pre-conference was organized in May
2008 and the Annual Conference will be held in September
2008. The theme of the conference is 'Softening the
hardened hearts: from brokenness to healing, from
forgiveness to unity.' Its aim is to provide a platform to
exchange ideas on theology, psychology and spiritual
disciplines, to explore strategies and countermeasures as to
how to develop a comprehensive holistic healing concept,

and to serve individuals and their families in crisis through the joint effort of the different healing ministries. The foundation hopes that in future this platform can be extended to China and Southeast Asia, to invite professionals, and brothers and sisters from these areas to participate.

Group Leaders Training

Rapha Foundation hopes to have extensive connections and collaboration with churches, to understand the specific needs of churches in the area of caring and counseling, to offer suitable training courses to equip pastoral workers and caring leaders, to help churches to train suitable group leaders for running the supplementary courses so that more brothers and sisters can join, and to train more 'caring companions' for individuals in need.

Building up a Caring Communities

Rapha Foundation hopes that through workshops, group sharing and prayer groups, emotionally distressed individuals are able to find caring companions to support and encourage each other in the process of their personal growth, and can become other's caring companions in the future.

Serving China

We have a vision to serve the emotionally distressed individuals in China. We hope that the Foundation's supplementary courses can be extended to China to help those in need. The aftermath of the Sichuan earthquake in May this year saw victims who are deeply wounded psychologically. Rapha Foundation has organized a 'Post-disaster Emotional Management Training Program' for severely affected areas of Sichuan. This program will last between 3 and 5 years, and will be offered to pastoral workers and brothers and sisters of churches in various cities of Sichuan. The program consists of a 3-stage psychological and spiritual training course in order to help them manage their emotions, to allow for deeper spiritual growth, and to build a closer relationship with God so that they can share the good news and comfort into people's lives. We also aim to train suitable group leaders so they can continue to run and lead training programs in other cities.
